The 2012 season at the Eastern Museum of Motor Racing was considered by many to be **one of the best ever** in the history of the EMMR and the Latimore Valley Fairgrounds.

Visitors enjoyed **expanded displays** in many areas, especially the newly-opened **Phase IV addition** which includes the **Chris Economaki Library** and the **Jerry Reigle Media Center**.

This off-season hasn't been as pressure-filled as last year, when the entire library and many other display areas within the museum had to be re-designed and re-located. However, it has still been a busy time heading into our **Spring Open House on April 6 & 7**. All of the credit goes to the dedicated **board, staff, and volunteers** who work unbelievably hard to make the museum and fairgrounds look beautiful for our friends and visitors.

Speaking of the Spring Open House, we are excited to announce our **special guest** this year will be noted broadcast and print journalist **Dick Berggren**. Berggren, the former editor of *Open Wheel* magazine and current publisher of *Dick Berggren's Speedway Illustrated* magazine, (www.speedwayillustrated.com), is also a highly respected NASCAR television commentator. As a former champion open wheel driver in the northeast U.S. and Canada, Berggren brings a colorful and passionate look at motor racing history.

While the Eastern Museum of Motor Racing has always had a mission of honoring all types of motor-sports, the expansion of the **drag racing display** area for last season brought many new friends to the EMMR. We look forward to continuing that strong support of drag racing history and will kick it off for 2013 with "**Drag Racing Saturday**" during our Spring Open House.

In 2013 visitors to the museum will see a much-expanded **sports car racing display** to honor the strong tradition of this racing venue in the eastern United States. Watch the EMMR website for more information about the historic sports cars that will be arriving.

We've always been proud of our **motorcycle displays**, developed over the years with the help of the late Kenny Rasp and others, but 2013 will find a completely new area for the public to enjoy the two-wheel machines. The **Potomac Vintage Riders** are designing a **display** for the EMMR that will tell the story of motorcycle competition, including the growth of the original motor cross and scrambles type events to the huge stadium motor cross and arena cross spectacles of today. In our continued effort to make our museum a leader in hands-on interactive displays for children and adults, we will have a complete **Pine Box Derby track** set up in the museum this year for youngsters to use. We were fortunate to be the beneficiary of the original 50+ year-old all-wood Pine Box Derby track from nearby **York Springs, Pa.**, when they went to a new track. We will even have cars available in the gift shop. This is just another great example of the EMMR mission to preserve the history of racing competition in as many areas as possible.

With all of the excitement surrounding the new display areas, we are never ones to forget our roots. In 2013 we will be honoring one of the finest racing fan clubs in existence, the **York County Racing Club** and their long-time leader **Paul Miller**. We will even have Miller's well-known **#133 stock car** displayed when you first enter the museum.

Added to the many EMMR display cases honoring area tracks will be a new one featuring **Susquehanna Speedway**. Local businessman and racing supporter **Donald Bricker**, whose father built Susquehanna in 1954, has been instrumental in locating photos and memorabilia for this display, together with current speedway owner **Todd Fisher**.

I know not all of you were acquainted with the late **Chuck Miller**. He was the epitome of a "behind-the-scenes" guy, who was never looking for recognition, but wanted to do all he could to help the cause. We lost Chuck last year to cancer, and, as was his manner, he just quietly slipped away from us. Chuck's estate left a substantial **bequest** to the museum and during the Spring Open House we will dedicate the "**Chuck Miller Theater**." We want to take this opportunity to remember and thank Chuck for all that he did to advance the Eastern Museum of Motor Racing.

We also want to thank the estates of the late **Chris Economaki** and **Buster Warke** for additional **bequests**. Supplementing these large donations are **29 gifts** for "**building blocks**" we have received to be engraved this spring. We can't tell you how important and appreciated these remembrances are. This thoughtful giving has allowed our treasurer to make meaningful payments on our Phase IV construction note. Please continue to remember the Eastern Museum of Motor Racing if you are doing **estate planning** or **annual gift planning**. It is important that we not only retire all building notes, but also to build an endowment fund to secure the future of the EMMR for coming generations to enjoy.

Volunteers are the lifeblood of many non-profit institutions, and the EMMR is no different. You have heard myself and others thank our volunteers multiple times. On behalf of the EMMR board, we'd like to


Prior to the Auction, **pictures and descriptions of each vehicle** were posted on a special website—www.EmmrAutoAuction.org. The event was a **consignment-style auction** with a **reserve**. The cost to register an auction spot for a vehicle was \$50.00.

A highlight of the Auction was a vehicle that is iconic with hot rodding and classic cars—a **1950 Mercury Coupe**, formerly owned by the late **Smokey Snellbaker**. Corvette... My Anti-Drug




